



Cooperative purchasing in Nevada is authorized by Nevada state statutes:

TITLE 27—PUBLIC PROPERTY AND PURCHASING
CHAPTER 332 - PURCHASING: LOCAL GOVERNMENTS
General Powers and Duties of Local Governments

NRS 332.195 Joinder or mutual use of contracts by governmental entities.

1. A governing body [counties, cities, towns, school districts] or its authorized representative and the State of Nevada may join or use the contracts of local governments located within or outside this State [e.g. NJPA contracts] with the authorization of the contracting vendor. The originally contracting local government is not liable for the obligations of the governmental entity which joins or uses the contract.
2. A governing body or its authorized representative may join or use the contracts of the State of Nevada or another state with the authorization of the contracting vendor. The State of Nevada or other state is not liable for the obligations of the local government which joins or uses the contract.
